If your application is approved, your EAD will be mailed to the mailing address on the application. If you have listed ISS as the mailing address, the advisor will notify you by email that it has arrived. In the very unlikely event that your application of the granted, you will receive an explanation for the denial.

If you do not receive your EAD within 90 days of the date your Notice of Action gives as the "Received Date," contact the ISS advisor.
