

Lawrence University Grading System

The grades available to instructors will vary depending on the grade mode of the course and the registration of the student. Most are standard and gradeable (see the catalog for more information about '+' and '-' values). 'U', and 'IP' grades may only be used if the restrictions below are met. 'I', 'W', and 'AU' may not be awarded by the course instructor.

S/U Grading: Only courses offered on an S/U-only basis may be graded 'S' (satisfactory; equivalent to a C- or better) or 'U' (unsatisfactory; equivalent to a D+ or lower). If a student has elected the S/U option, the instructor must record a regular 'A-F' grade. This option of the letter grade go an 'S' or 'U' is
