

A Guide to the Degree Summary Report

A degree summary is made available to all current degree-seeking students completing requirements for any degree program from 1996-97 to the present. Degree summaries can be viewed through the Voyager Infor. The degree summary shows the results of a computer audit of a student's academic record.

The degree audit is based on the student's catalog year. The catalog year noted at the top of the summary report indicates the set of requirements used for the audit. Students may elect to complete requirements in effect the year they matriculated at Lawrence or the year they intend to complete their course of study. Students may not mix-and-match requirements from several different catalogs.

The degree audit reviews completion of degree requirements only. Students have ultimate responsibility for selecting a course of study to complete all degree requirements and for monitoring their progress. The degree summary report is a tool to assist students and academic advisors in this process. Monitoring progress in completing requirements for majors, minors, interdisciplinary areas, and areas of emphasis remains a separate task and must be done manually by students and advisors. The completion of at least one major is required for each degree. Students should review their progress in completing degree and
